After all bids are received and the highest bid is reported to the Bryson City Board of Aldermen, the Alderman will accept or reject the highest bid within 30 days. It is the responsibility of the highest bidder to remove the vehicle from the Town premises within 10 days of notification or their bid is forfeited to next highest bidder.
